To be run under PC eventing rules

RULES

1. This event will be run and judged in accordance with The Current Pony Club Eventing Rules.

HOWEVER, because this is a Mini event, some rules have been relaxed. If there is any dispute relating to the relaxation of the Rules, we reserve the right to revert fully to The Current Official Pony Club Rules as stated above.

In all classes, Competitors, if eliminated in either the Show Jumping or Cross Country, will be able to continue at the judge's discretion and if time allows. On the Cross Country course competitors will be required to follow the instruction of the Cross Country Steward.

- 2. The decisions of the Judges, Organisers and The Official Steward are final. Any objections or complaints regarding any matter of any nature whatsoever must be submitted in writing to the Official Steward at the Secretary's office with a £10 fee within 15 minutes of the incident, judgement or release of scores or score sheets.
- 3. Correct riding attire must be worn. Hard hats adhering to current Pony Club rules must be worn, tagged and fastened when mounted. Body protectors, meeting current Pony Club standards, are compulsory for the Cross Country and recommended for the Show Jumping. No earrings/piercings or jewellery to be worn. No head cams are allowed.
- No pony may be entered in more than one class. No competitor may enter more than two ponies.
 No stallions will be allowed to attend or compete at this event.
- 5. Withdrawals will be refunded only on production of a Medical or Veterinary certificate within 14 days of the event date, A £5 administration fee will be deducted. There will be no refunds after the times have been posted.
- 6. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry at their discretion without stating a reason, and to alter, amend or cancel any part of the competition.
- 7. The final results will be posted online at: www.lordlecpc.org
- If the event is cancelled for any reason, every effort will be made to send an email to each individual to notify them. A decision will be made AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE BUT PLEASE CHECK OUR WEBSITE IF IN ANY DOUBT.

The decision will also be posted on the branch website. Please do not telephone. If the event is cancelled, entry fees will be refunded less the sum of £5 per entry to cover administration.

- 9. Cruelty to ponies, misuse of whips or spurs, unseemly or aggressive behaviour, blatant bad language by riders, parents / guardians, trainers or supporters, may incur elimination or disqualification.
- 10. Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times and all mess picked up and taken home
- 11. In view of recent accidents, ponies tied up to the outside of horseboxes or trailers MUST NOT be left unattended.

Health & Safety

Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.

Legal Liability

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
